3. **Book Mobile:** create a mobile using the four story elements (setting, character, plot & theme).



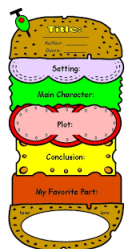
4. **Postcard** (see attached template with directions)
