

Dear SJS Families,

The Student Council has come up with a fundraising idea; **Coin Wars!!!** Coin Wars is a week-long fundraiser for grades 4-8. Grades Pre-K-3 are doing a separate fundraiser that also has to do with coins. All raised money will go directly to St. John's School. Profits will go towards Student Appreciation Day in Catholic Schools Week.

Grades 4-8: You can put coins in your grades jar at lunch, and bills in other grades jars. Coins count for their monetary value, and bills are their monetary value negative. For example, if you put three quarters in your grades jar, your grade has a total of 0.75. But if someone else puts a dollar in your grades jar, the total is -0.25. This fundraiser will be from Monday, January 24th, through Friday, January 28th. The grade with the highest total at the end of the week will win a pizza party in the following week. If your child is bringing in money, please put it in a safe place. If they are bringing a packed lunch, they can put the money in their lunchbox, as the jars are in the lunchroom.

Grades Pre-K -3: On Monday, January 24th, please have your child bring as many pennies as they can to school. The grade with the most pennies at the end of the day will get a special prize the next day. On Tuesday, the same is true for nickels; on Wednesday, dimes; on Thursday, quarters; and on Friday, one dollar bills. Teachers will collect coins and bills at the start of each school day. If a student brings in the wrong coin or bill, it will be returned and not counted to the grades total.
